VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APPROACHING

Acting Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), Dean Logan, today reminded Los Angeles County residents that the voter registration deadline for the upcoming February 5, 2008 Presidential Primary Election is Tuesday, January 22, 2008.

Persons wishing to register must be United States citizens, residents of Los Angeles County, not in prison or on parole for conviction of a felony, and who will be at least 18 years of age by election day.

Voter registration forms are available throughout the County at approximately 1,240 locations, including libraries, fire stations, post offices, and city clerk offices. Assistance in registering to vote is also provided by staff at the Department of Motor Vehicles and at designated Public Social Services agencies. Los Angeles County residents may telephone the RR/CC's Election Information Section at (562) 466-1310 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays to obtain information regarding locations where registration-by-mail forms are available. Telephone requests for registration forms are accepted 24 hours a day, seven days a week by calling the Election Information number (562) 466-1310. The postage-paid forms will be mailed no later than one day after the request is received.

Prospective voters may also register at the RR/CC's Office, 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk any time between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, through January 22nd. Additionally, registration forms and a deposit box for completed forms will be available in the front lobby of the RR/CC's Office until midnight on January 22nd. RR/CC staff will be available in the lobby thru midnight on January 22nd for those persons who may have questions or who need registration assistance.
