NOMINATION PERIOD BEGINS FOR JUNE 3, 2008 PRIMARY ELECTION

Acting Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced today that persons intending to run for office in the June 3 Primary election may file nomination papers beginning Monday, February 11 through Friday, March 7. (See attached list of offices to be filled).

Candidates can register to receive official nomination filing documents in person, by mail, and on the RR/CC website at www.lavote.net. Candidates wishing to obtain nomination filing documents in person can do so at RR/CC Headquarters, 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, Election Information Section, Second floor, Room 2013. Candidates wishing to register online can access the Candidate Registration and Qualification form through the RR/CC homepage www.lavote.net. Candidates can complete the form online and transmit information directly back to the RR/CC. Once received, the official candidate nomination filing documents will be prepared within 48 hours (excluding holidays and weekends). Candidates must sign the documents and pay the required fee (See fee schedule attached).

Candidates may also authorize another person to pick up their nomination documents from the RR/CC Norwalk location and return the signed documents by completing an authorization form. An authorization form is available on the RR/CC website, or can be obtained in person at the RR/CC Headquarters.

The last day to submit online Candidate Registration and Qualification forms for the June 3, 2008 Primary Election is Thursday, March 6.

The legal deadline to file candidate nomination documents for the June 3 Elections is Friday, March 7, 2008 at 5:00 pm

This handbook contains critical deadlines, rules and guidelines for campaigning, campaign finance disclosure filing requirements and other valuable information.
