DEPUTY REGISTRAR TRAINING PROGRAM

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) will begin new sessions of the Deputy Registrar Training program. Members of organizations and individuals who register voters and conduct absent voting and petition drives are encouraged to participate in this program. Topics covered include the proper methods and techniques for registering voters, assisting electors with the completion of voter registration forms, and important California election codes related to registration requirements.

RR/CC Conny McCormack said, "Staff at the RR/CC is committed to providing County residents with the opportunity to register to vote. It is important to ensure that registration forms are properly completed to prevent delays and complications in the registration and election process. The Deputy Registrar Training program will help us in attaining this goal and will assist in our efforts to provide convenient and efficient registration services."

Sessions for Certification Training will be held from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk Headquarters, 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA, room 3207 on February 12th, March 26th, April 23rd, May 21st, June 25th, August 27th, September 10th, and October 1st. Those interested in attending the training can select the session of their choice. Participants will receive a Deputy Registrar of Voters Certificate upon the successful completion of the training program.
