36TH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT VACANCY INFORMATION

Vacancy Information

Congresswoman Jane Harman resigned from her 36th Congressional District seat effective February 28, 2011. The Governor has until March 14, 2011, to call the Special General Election for this vacancy. The Special Primary Election will be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy for the unexpired 2 year term which ends on January 3, 2013.

Signatures In Lieu of Filing Fee

The Petition In Lieu of Filing Fee forms became available on March 1, 2011, for this vacancy, for persons wishing to secure signatures in lieu of all or a portion of the filing fee.

Petition In Lieu of Filing Fee forms are available from the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650, 2nd Floor, Room 2013, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., weekdays.

Qualified signatures submitted on the in lieu petition form may also be applied to satisfy the required nominating signatures. Persons filing signatures in-lieu of filing fees will be notified within ten calendar days of filing the Petition In Lieu of Filing Fee form regarding the result of the signature verification. Signatures collected will be credited towards filing fees on a pro rata basis.
