MARCH 8, 2011 BELL CITY GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL RECALL ELECTIONS SEMI-FINAL RESULTS REPORTED

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced semi-final election results for the March 8, 2011 City of Bell General Municipal and Special Recall Elections with 100% of the precincts reporting, 29.76% of eligible registered voters cast ballots in the City of Bell.

A total of 3,120 ballots were processed and counted on Election Night. This included 481 Vote by Mail ballots and 2,639 polling place ballots cast at the 4 voting precincts throughout the city.

The official election canvass will take place beginning Wednesday, March 9, 2011 through Friday, March 18, 2011. Supplemental election result updates throughout the canvass period may be accessed via the RR/CC website www.lavote.net. The first supplemental results update will be posted Friday, March 11 after 5:00 p.m. Additional updates will be posted Tuesday, March 15, 2011 with the final official election results posted on Tuesday, March 22, 2011.

During the Official Canvass all outstanding provisional and vote by mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will conduct the 1% Manual Audit. Upon completion of the Official Canvass for the General Municipal and Special Recall Elections results will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for official certification of the election.
