NOMINATION PERIOD OPEN FOR 36TH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION ON MAY 17, 2011

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced that persons intending to run for office in the 36th Congressional District Special Primary Election on May 17, 2011, may now file nomination documents through Friday, March 25, 2011 at 5 p.m.

Nomination forms may be requested and filed back with the RR/CC at 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650, 2nd Floor, Room 2013, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Qualifications and Requirements

Persons intending to run for office must be 25 years of age or older and a United States citizen for at least 7 years and a resident of California when elected.

The filing fee is \$1740.00 and 40-60 nominating signatures are required. All candidates must pay the nonrefundable filing fee at the time they obtain their nomination papers or submit a minimum of 3,000 valid signatures in-lieu of filing fees by March 17, 2011. Petition In Lieu of Filing Fee forms are available from the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650, 2nd Floor, Room 2013, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., weekdays.

About This Election

The Governor issued a proclamation calling for a Special Vacancy General Election in the 36th

(MORE)

Congressional District to be held on July 12, 2011. The Primary Election for the Special Vacancy elections has been set for May 17, 2011.

The Special Vacancy Election is being held for the purpose of filling the vacancy for the unexpired 2 year term ending January 3, 2013, in the 36th Congressional District. The seat was declared vacant when former Congresswoman Jane Harman resigned from office on February 28, 2011.
