**VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APPROACHING**

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), Conny McCormack, today reminded Los Angeles County residents that the voter registration deadline for the upcoming May 15, 2007 39<sup>th</sup> State Assembly District Special Primary Election and the City of Los Angeles General Municipal election is April 30, 2007.

Persons wishing to register must be United States citizens, residents of Los Angeles County, not in prison or on parole for conviction of a felony, and who will be at least 18 years of age by election day.

Voter registration forms are available throughout the County at approximately 1,240 locations, including libraries, fire stations, post offices, and city clerk offices. Assistance in registering to vote is also provided by staff at the Department of Motor Vehicles and designated Public Social Services agencies. Los Angeles County residents may telephone the RR/CC's Election Information Section at (562) 466-1310 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays to obtain information regarding location near them to pick-up registration-by-mail forms. Telephone requests for registration forms can be made using the Election Information number 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The postage-paid forms will be mailed within a day after the request is received. To register to vote online, go to [www.lavote.net](http://www.lavote.net) and click on the Vote Registration icon.

Persons may also register at the RR/CC's Office, 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk during normal office hours 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday - Friday, through April 30th.
