### VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APPROACHING FOR THE MAY 17, 2011 CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 36 SPECIAL PRIMARY AND CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan today reminded eligible residents in the 36<sup>th</sup> Congressional District that Monday May 2, 2011 is the last day to register to vote in the upcoming Congressional District 36 Special Primary and Consolidated Elections on May 17 2011.

Individuals who wish to register must at least be 18 years of age by Election Day, a U.S. Citizen and resident of Los Angeles County, and not in prison or on parole for conviction of a felony. If you are an active registered voter you do not need to re-register. Voters should re-register to vote if they have recently moved, made a legal name change, or wish to change political party affiliation, the voter must re-register to vote. Individuals must reside within the 36<sup>th</sup> Congressional District to vote on May 17.

Voter registration forms are also available by calling the *Voter Registration Request Line* – (800) 481-VOTE (8883) or at over 1,240 locations across the County – including Department of Motor Vehicles offices, libraries, fire stations, post offices, public assistance offices (DPSS, WIC), and City Clerks offices.

Voter Registration forms must be submitted to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk or City Clerk's Office today. Postmarked forms will be accepted.

**NOTE:** The RR/CC will be open until Midnight to receive Voter Registration forms.

### **About the Special Primary Election**

The Special Primary Election is being held for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the 36th Congressional District, resulting from the resignation of office by former Congresswoman Jane Harman on February 28, 2011. The person elected will serve the unexpired 2 year term ending at midnight on January 3, 2013.

If a candidate receives a majority of votes cast (50% +1) in the Special Primary Election, they will be declared the winner and no General Election will be held on July 12, 2011.

### **About the Consolidated Election**

In portions of the district within the City of Los Angeles, voters will also be voting in the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) Seat No. 5 General Run-Off Election. The election was consolidated onto the Special Primary Ballot.
