LOCAL BALLOT DROP-OFF LOCATIONS SET FOR SANTA MONICA-MALIBU UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SPECIAL PARCEL TAX ELECTION

Dean Logan, Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) is reminding voters that local ballot drop-off locations have been established for the May 25, 2010 Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election. The following locations will be open on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Voters may drop-off un-mailed voted ballots at any of the three locations listed below:

Note: These are not voting locations. RR/CC staff will be on hand to accept voted ballots or provide replacement envelopes only.

IMPORTANT TIPS

- All voted ballots must be received by the RR/CC by May 25, 2010, no later than 8 p.m., whether returning the ballot by mail to the RR/CC or dropping it off at one of the satellite ballot drop-off locations.
- If you have not received a Vote by Mail ballot, call the RR/CC, Vote by Mail Section, at (562) 466-1323. Voters can track the status of their Vote by Mail ballot online at www.lavote.net.
- Voters who misplace or damage their Official Vote by Mail ballot and/or Sample Ballot booklet, may obtain a replacement by contacting the RR/CC, Vote by Mail Section, at (562) 466-1323 or in person at the RR/CC Headquarters, 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650 prior to Election Day.
