AVAILABLE ONLINE RESOURCES FOR THE MAY 19, 2009 STATEWIDE SPECIAL AND CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan encourages voters to use the RR/CC website as an online election resource to follow the activities of the RR/CC for the May 19, 2009 Statewide Special and Consolidated Elections. For the first time in a statewide election, the RR/CC is utilizing numerous multi-media options to provide voters instant access to Election Day activities, operations, and results. Throughout the day, the RR/CC will provide updates on, important voter notices, estimated turnout, precinct ballots arriving at designated check-in centers, and semi-official election returns.

The multi-media options utilized by the RR/CC include www.lavote.net, Twitter, video blogs, RSS feeds, and the RR/CC's YouTube channel. Specific instructions for voters on how to access the various online resources are available below:

 - to follow us on Twitter and receive updates on the progress of election activities (main page in the *Connect With Us* box by clicking the *Twitter* icon, or on the *Press Room* page by clicking the *Blogs and Tweets* tab, or the *Twitter* icon in the *Connect With Us* box)
 - informational updates on the election directly from RR/CC Dean Logan via webcast, as available (main page by clicking the *Press Room* tab and then clicking the *Blogs and Tweets* tab)
