MAY 17, 2011 CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 36 SPECIAL PRIMARY AND CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS SEMI-FINAL ELECTION RESULTS REPORTED

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced semi-final election results for the May 17, 2011 Congressional District 36 Special Primary and Consolidated Elections with 100% of the precincts reporting, 15.54% of eligible registered voters cast ballots in the district.

A total of 53,659 ballots were processed and counted on Election Night. This included 25,949 Vote By Mail ballots and 27,710 polling place ballots cast at the 254 voting precincts throughout the district. As of election night processing, we estimate 9,811 ballots remaining to be processed. This includes Vote By Mail, provisional and withheld ballots.

The official election canvass will take place beginning Wednesday, May 18, 2011 through Friday, May 20, 2011. During the Official Canvass all outstanding provisional and vote by mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct the 1% Manual Audit. The next scheduled update will be available Friday, May 20 and can be accessed via the RR/CC website www.lavote.net.

On Friday, May 20, 2011, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results to the Secretary of State for the Congressional District 36 Special Primary and Consolidated Elections upon completion of the Official Canvass.
