200 POLLWORKERS STILL NEEDED FOR THE JUNE 8, 2010 PRIMARY ELECTION

Dean Logan, Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), again called on registered voters to support the democratic process by serving as Pollworkers in the June 8th Statewide Direct Primary Elections. About 200 pollworkers are still needed to serve in communities throughout the county.

Logan said, "The contributions that Pollworkers make strengthen our democratic process." Pollworkers must be available to serve between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 pm. Pollworkers are compensated \$80 for working Election Day, plus \$25 for attending a 2 hour training session. Training sessions are currently scheduled at convenient locations and hours throughout Los Angeles County.
