### VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APPROACHING FOR THE SEPTEMBER 1, 2009 51ST STATE ASSEMBLY DISTRICT SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan today reminded Los Angeles County residents that the last day to register to vote for the upcoming September 1, 2009 51st State Assembly District Special Primary Election is Monday, August 17, 2009.

Individuals who wish to register must be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, a U.S. Citizen and resident of Los Angeles County, and not in prison or on parole for conviction of a felony. If the voter has recently moved, made a legal name change, or wishes to change political party affiliation, the voter must re-register to vote. Individuals must reside within the 51st State Assembly District to vote in the Election.

An online voter registration form is available through the RR/CC website [www.lavote.net](http://www.lavote.net) by clicking the *Register to Vote* button located in the *Quick Links* box of the main page or by calling the *Voter Registration Request Line* - (800) 481-VOTE (8683). Voter registration forms are also available at over 1,240 locations across the County – including Department of Motor Vehicles offices, libraries, fire stations, post offices, public assistance offices (DPSS, WIC), and City Clerk offices.
