Lynwood City Special Recall Election**

The Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) will be conducting the Lynwood City Special Recall Election on September 25, 2007. The purpose of the Recall Election is to submit to the voters within the City of Lynwood the question of whether Louis Byrd, Alfreddie Johnson, Fernando Pedroza and Leticia Vasquez should be recalled as members of the City Council, and for the election of candidates to fill the vacancy in each of these offices if the recall(s) prevail.

ABSENTEE VOTING PERIOD

For voters wishing to vote by mail, the deadline to request an absentee ballot is Tuesday, September 18. Under special circumstances, a voter may request an emergency absentee ballot beginning Wednesday, September 19 through Election Day, September 25 at the RR/CC's headquarters in Norwalk. VOTES NEEDED TO ELECT CANDIDATE

A majority of votes (50% + 1) is needed to recall. If recall prevails, the candidate with the most votes is elected as successor for remainder of term.
