REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK PARTNERS WITH COMMUNITY BASED EFFORT TO HELP PROMOTE VOTER PARTICIPATION

As part of continuing our mission of conducting fair, accessible and transparent elections, Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County (RR/CC) Clerk Dean Logan today announced a countywide partnership with the California Participation Project. Kicking off efforts in anticipation of the November 2nd Election, on Wednesday the RR/CC co-sponsored a large-scale training for nonprofit organizations in Los Angeles, coordinated by the project. The training included 40 organizations who gathered to learn about how to help promote the election.

The California Participation Project (CPP) is a non-partisan community effort that will offer an opportunity for non-profit organizations in L.A., to partake in training programs that include effective methods of increasing voter participation, as well as voter education resources. The RR/CC is helping to support the project by providing essential voter registration and voter education trainings and resources to participating organizations. "The strength of our democratic process depends on the active participation of its citizens, our office looks forward to working with CPP," said Dean Logan Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

The California Participation Project (CPP) is committed to providing trainings, resources and tools that 501(c)(3) nonprofits can access leading up to the November 2nd Statewide Election. CPP is part of a statewide and national project to create a sustainable civic engagement infrastructure for communities served by the non-profit sector.

"The LA County Registrar Recorder has been an invaluable partner in our efforts to promote voter engagement initiatives at nonprofits, by providing resources and information that we can disseminate to help people overcome barriers to voting," said California Project Partner, Sarah Pillsbury.
