REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK TO REACH OUT TO MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTERS IN SUPPORT OF NATIONAL ABSENTEE WEEK

As part of the United States Department of Defense's "Absentee Voters Week", Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) will conduct a series of outreach activities to Military and Overseas voters. The effort seeks to inform Military and Overseas voters about registering and voting and requesting a ballot for the upcoming November 2nd General Election.

Kicking off the week the RR/CC today, joined Los Angeles Air Force Base (LA AFB) for their week long voter registration drive. The effort will reach out to the military and other base personnel as well as their families to assist them with voter registration or with requesting a ballot through using the Federal Post Card Application for military personnel. The drive will take place from Monday, September 27, 2010 through Monday, October 4, 2010. LA AFB is located at 400 North Douglas Street, El Segundo, CA 90245. (The LA AFB street address is 483 N. Aviation Blvd., El Segundo, CA 90245)

The RR/CC will also reach out to the more than 26,018 Military and Overseas voters currently residing outside of the County via email, providing them with important deadlines and resources to help them cast their vote this November 2nd. Finally, efforts will also outreach to the approximately 90 military recruitment centers throughout the County, from all branches of the military.

Registrar of Voters, Dean Logan said, “Los Angelenos serving in our armed forces or working abroad are serving as ambassadors of our nation, state and county. Assisting them and helping to preserve their right to vote is our way of serving them, if even in a small way.”

The Department of Defense has also made absentee voting for the military easier. Online voters can click the link <http://www.fvap.gov/> to fill in the FPCA using a wizard that assists the absentee voter in filling in the form based on their particular state/county or residence. Once completed the voter simply prints out the form, signs it, along with their postage –paid envelope template, and returns the form to their local election official.
