VOTER REGISTRATION SERVICES AND ELECTION INFORMATION AVAILABLE AT THE NEW KOREAN COMMUNITY 2008 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION INFORMATION CENTER

In a collaborative effort with the Korean Daily News and JBC AM 1230, Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced today that voter registration services and election information will be available through Election Day, November 4, at the new Korean Community 2008 Presidential Election Information Center at 690 Wilshire Place, Los Angeles, CA 90005.

Logan said, "We applaud the Korean Daily News and JBC AM 1230 for creating the Election Information Center and for their efforts to increase interest and participation by members of the public, particularly those in the Korean Community, to engage in the democratic process by obtaining election information and registering to vote. Los Angeles County has the largest Korean Community outside of Korea and we are excited that the RR/CC can help make voter registration services and election information easily available to them as the November 4 Presidential General Election approaches."

The RR/CC encourages all eligible residents to register to vote before the October 20, 2008 close of registration deadline so that they can cast a vote in the upcoming Presidential General Election. "In particular, we encourage first time voters to get engaged with the elections process," said Logan.

Los Angeles County serves all voters including those with specific needs. Polling places are equipped with audio ballot booths that provide audio translation of ballots in seven languages, including Korean, and other assistive services for voters with disabilities. Registration and election materials are also available in seven languages to serve citizens with limited English proficiency.
