AND LONG BEACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ELECTIONS**

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), Conny McCormack, announced today that persons intending to run for office in the Long Beach Unified School District Board of Education Election and Long Beach Community College District Board of Trustees Election on April 8, 2008, may begin filing nomination papers with the RR/CC's Office beginning Monday, December 17, 2007 at 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Room 2013, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Unified School District election is being held for the purpose of electing two members to the Board of Education, districts 2 and 4. The Community College District election is being held for the purpose of electing two members to the Board of Trustees, trustee areas 2 and 4. The deadline for filing nomination papers is Friday, January 11, 2008 at 5:00 p.m.

The Unified School District election will be held in consolidation with the primary nominating election held in the City of Long Beach and the general municipal election to be held in the City of Avalon. The Community College District election will be held in consolidation with the primary nominating election held in the City of Long Beach and the general municipal elections to be held in the Cities of Avalon and Signal Hill.
