NOMINATION PERIOD OPEN FOR ARCADIA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION ON APRIL 21, 2009

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced today that persons intending to run for office in the Arcadia Unified School District Board of Education Election on April 21, 2009, may begin filing nomination documents beginning Monday, December 29, 2008 through Friday, January 23, 2009 with the RR/CC at 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650, 2nd Floor, Room 2013, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The school district election is being held to elect two members to the Board of Education. Candidates must be registered voters residing within the district at the time nomination documents are issued and must be otherwise qualified to vote for the office for which he or she is filing. A minimum of 20 to a maximum of 30 nominating signatures is required. There is no filing fee. The term of office is for four years beginning on or before the 2nd Tuesday in July following the election.

If nomination documents for an incumbent are not filed by 5 p.m. on January 23, the nomination period shall be extended until Wednesday, January 28 until 5 p.m., for persons other than the incumbent. If the number of persons who have been nominated to the offices does not exceed the number to be filled, appointment to the elective offices may be made by the Board of Education as prescribed by Section 10229 of the Elections Code. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast at the April 21st election are elected to fill the offices.
