CANDIDATE INFORMATION FOR JUNE 5, 2012 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

Period for Collecting Signatures in Lieu of Filing Fees for Candidate Nomination Begins

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced that persons interested in running for office in the June 5, 2012 Presidential Primary Election may begin collecting signatures in lieu of filing fees. Interested persons may request Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee petitions at RR/CC Norwalk Offices located at 12400 Imperial Highway Norwalk, CA 90650.

Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee Petitions

Pursuant to California Election Code § 8106(a)(3) & (b)(3), for all offices requiring a filing fee, candidates may collect signatures of registered voters residing in the jurisdiction and submit them in lieu of paying the required filing fees. Signatures in Lieu of the Filing Fee must be submitted at the time the candidate applies for Nomination Documents.

Provided below are important dates and deadlines pertaining to the Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee process for all candidates:

- December 30, 2011 to February 8, 2012
Judicial candidates only - petition forms may be obtained to secure Signatures in Lieu of all or a portion of the filing fee. February 8, 2012 is the last day for candidates for judicial office to file Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee petitions.
- December 30, 2011 to February 23, 2012
All candidates, excluding judicial candidates - petition forms may be obtained to secure signatures in lieu of all or a portion of the filing fee. February 23, 2012 is the last day for all candidates, excluding judicial candidates, to file Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee petitions.

Important dates and deadlines pertaining to the Signature in Lieu of Filing Fee process for all candidates (continued):

- March 5*, 2012
All candidates - last day for RR/CC to determine sufficiency of signatures submitted in lieu of filing fees.
- March 9, 2012
All candidates – last day candidates may submit a supplemental petition or pay a pro rata fee if the signature in lieu of filing fee petition initially filed was deficient.

*Date adjusted due to weekend and/or holiday.
