# VOTER BILL OF RIGHTS

## REMEMBER

- ★ Polls are open on Election Day from 7:00 am to 8:00 PM.
- ★ You can find your polling place and other valuable information at [www.LAVOTE.net](http://www.LAVOTE.net)

★ You have the right to cast a ballot if you are a registered voter.

★ You have the right to receive assistance casting your ballot.

★ You have the right to cast a provisional ballot if your name is not listed on the voting rolls.

★ You have the right to return a completed vote-by-mail ballot to any precinct in the county.

★ You have the right to cast a ballot if you are in line at the polling place before 8:00 PM.

★ You have the right to election materials in another language. L.A. County provides materials in 10 different languages.

★ You have the right to cast a secret ballot free from intimidation.

★ You have the right to ask questions about election procedures and to observe the election process.

★ You have the right to receive a new ballot if you think you made a mistake before you drop it in the ballot box.

★ You have the right to report any illegal or fraudulent activity to an elections official or to the Secretary of State's Office.
