LOCAL JURISDICTION MEASURES – (2)

LA CAÑADA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

- LC** – To protect La Cañada schools from uncontrollable state budget cuts and preserve quality education through temporary local funding to sustain rigorous curriculum and instruction; attract and retain superior teachers; limit increased class sizes; maintain programs that ensure students are prepared to succeed in college and careers; and protect property values, shall La Cañada Unified School District levy \$150 per parcel for five years, with independent citizens' oversight, exemptions for seniors, and all funds staying under local control?

ROWLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

- E** – To prevent deep cuts in local educational programs, including: maintaining college preparation classes, high school counselors, student health/safety/security services, adequate instructional supplies and classroom technology; keeping school libraries open; protecting small class sizes and music/art programs; and retaining qualified teachers; shall Rowland Unified School District levy an annual \$120 tax per parcel, for 5 years only, with independent oversight, and exemption for seniors, no money for administrator salaries, and all funds benefiting Rowland Unified schools?
